

# RECORDS RETENTION REQUIREMENTS IN EDUCATION

That's going on your permanent record! (Which means it has to be stored, and protected.)

FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) dictates a 1-3 year minimum retention period for different types of student data, but states often have their own requirements above and beyond FERPA. This map shows K-12 retention requirements by state for student transcripts. Other types of records may have different requirements.
